<p>Who can enter and how to enter?</p>	<p>This Competition is only open to entry from authors who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • have submitted a paper(s) in response to the ACDC 2023 call for papers, deadline of 10 October 2022 • have had such paper(s) accepted for presentation at the Conference; • in the case of the Best Paper category, have had their paper selected as one of the short list of 9; • have purchased a ticket to attend the ACDC Conference (as detailed below). <p>The Competition is not open to entry from (and we reserve the right to disqualify) anyone who;</p> <p>(A) is our employee or an employee of any company (including any holding or subsidiary company) or charitable institution within the IET's group;</p> <p>(B) is an employee of any agent or supplier who is professionally connected with the Competition (including its administration) or any sponsor of the Competition;</p> <p>(C) is a member of the immediate family (meaning a child, parent or guardian) or living in the same household as any individuals who fall under the categories set out (A) or (B) above; or</p> <p>(D) is an individual listed on any financial sanction list or living in a country which is subject to financial sanctions</p>

	<p>imposed by the United Nations, the United Kingdom, the United States, the European Union or any other jurisdiction.</p> <p>(E) does not attend the Conference for any reason.</p> <p>During the period (20.02.23 – 21.02.23), we will send out an email to those authors who meet the specific eligibility criteria set out above inviting them to enter the Competition (the “Invite”).</p> <p>If you are one of the eligible authors and wants to enter the Competition, you must respond to the Invite confirming that you wish to enter. By doing so you are confirming your agreement to the Standard Competition Terms.</p> <p>Your entry to the Competition will be the paper(s) that you have already submitted and which has/have been accepted for presentation. No amendments can be made to your paper(s).</p> <p>Competition entries shall be divided into 2 categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ‘Best Paper’ category: open to eligible authors whose paper(s) has/have been accepted for an oral presentation at the Conference; and • Best Poster category: open to eligible authors whose paper(s) has/have been accepted to be displayed as a poster at the Conference. <p>If you opt in to entering the Competition, your paper(s) will be automatically entered into the applicable category. Please note that entries shall be limited to one entry per paper per topic for the relevant category.</p>

Judging of the Competition entries.	<p>The winner of the Best Paper category will be the paper from the shortlist which achieves the highest score against the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Innovation and originality• Contribution and advancement• Quality• Accuracy• Interaction <p>as determined by a judging panel made up of a minimum of 3 members of the ACDC 2023 Organising Committee. Judging will take place (21.02.23 – 27.02.23).</p> <p>The winner of the Best Poster category will be decided by a vote of Conference attendees. All posters will be on display at the Conference and voters will be able to select the best poster using the online voting form provided to attendees. Voting will close at 15:00 BST on Wednesday 2nd March 2023.</p>
The Prizes	<p>If your paper is selected as the winner of either category, you will receive:</p> <p>A certificate and choice of a single volume book* (print or e-book**) from the IET academy *</p> <p>*choice excludes Electrical Regulations, Codes and Guidance, or Model Forms sections along with such other titles as may be notified to you by the IET.</p> <p>**e-books will be subject to you agreeing to any applicable terms of use/access.</p> <p>Winners will be asked to make their selection from the The IET Shop – Books and send their selection to acdc@theiet.org. Prizes must be claimed within 3 months of the initial Winner's announcement.</p> <p>Prizes will only be awarded to the main author of winning papers irrespective of whether the paper includes any contribution by co-authors.</p> <p>If we exercise our right to replace prizes under clause 8.3 of the Standard Competition Terms, we will notify the eligible entrants.</p>
